



Hobart Airport Filming Policy

The following information refers to filming at Hobart Airport in areas managed by Hobart Airport, should you wish to film in other areas, you will need to contact the relevant body directly.

In order to make an assessment of filming at Hobart Airport, we require some details (as much as you have available) about your planned activities at Hobart Airport. The following information would assist in this assessment -

- The story line of the film, or the context in which the scene you are filming/photographing will be used;
- Brief description of the scene(s) you are intending to film/photograph at Hobart Airport;
- Duration of filming/photographic shoot detailing exact dates, days and times you intend to film;
- Exact location(s) of film/photographic shoot;
- Type of equipment you will be using and bringing with you ;
- The number of pieces of equipment you will be bringing with you;
- The number of persons who will be on site including any talent/actors and crew members;
- Any other information that you feel would be of use for Hobart Airport.

Hobart Airport prefers that hand-held equipment only be used and the number of crew attending any one film shoot session be kept to a minimum (up to five members would be ideal). This is to ensure that your film/photographic shoot activities will not interfere with the passenger flow and/or passenger processing.

If you are intending to film/photograph aircraft movements or include any airline property in your scenes, you will need to obtain permission from the respective airlines.

You must refrain from filming/photographing any members of staff or personnel of the Australian Federal Police, Australian Protective Services and any security staff in the Airport, or any of their functions and processes..

Parking is available in the public car park directly in front of the Terminal building at the published rates. No special parking spaces will be allocated.

Hobart Airport will require sighting of a certificate of currency to ensure that you are covered by appropriate levels of insurance, and you will also need to sign Hobart Airport's indemnity form.

Please appreciate that in the current world climate there have been many changes at the Airport and we have to impose a higher level of stringency on all requests. Your request will be assessed based on the information and the level of detail that is provided.

Filming / Photography Charges

Hobart Airport has a base charge of \$500 to be paid in advance for approved filming at the Airport.

The base charge will be followed by a \$200 per hour landside charge and a \$250 per hour airside charge (exclusive of GST).
Costs may be negotiated under certain circumstances.

If you are intending to film/photograph anywhere other than the general public areas, you will need security passes from the Airport. Should you require any extra resources or equipment, including room hire or such from us, extra fees will be incurred.

Crews will be escorted at all times when at Hobart Airport.
