



QantasLink announces new services from Hobart commencing March 8 2016

Today Rod Parry, CEO Hobart Airport welcomed QantasLink CEO John Gissing to Hobart Airport. Mr Gissing was in town to announce new QantasLink services between Hobart, Melbourne and Sydney.

The highly anticipated services will enable same day business travel between Hobart and Sydney and provide better connections to many international services.

The services will be operated by a new 717 aircraft that will be based in Hobart, doubling the QantasLink crew living in the Hobart community.

“Our key objective in growing Hobart Airport is to provide a great travelling experience for our customers while continuing to improve Tasmanian’s connectedness to Australia and the wider World. We cannot achieve this without our Airline partners.

Since Qantas Link commenced operations at Hobart Airport just over 17 months ago they have carried over 410,000 passengers between Hobart, Melbourne and Sydney, have flown over 4,500 flights and improved frequency and connectivity for customers. This increase in the number of services and greater frequency has provided greater and more convenient travel options for Tasmania, importantly it has contributed to our economic growth.” Mr Parry said.
