

Energy Use Reduction Policy

This policy outlines the key principles for improving energy use and reducing emissions where practical from our direct operations, and supporting our stakeholders to achieve their energy use goals.

Hobart Airport is committed to engaging, educating, and collaborating with our staff, contractors, tenants, and stakeholders to balance environmental, social, and business needs as we operate and grow.

Our goal is to reduce energy use and emissions within our operations where practical. This will be achieved through the following principles:

- We will minimise our environmental and emissions impact by integrating sustainability principles and continual improvement into our decision-making processes, including planning, design, development, service delivery, and procurement.
- Hobart Airport is committed to achieving net zero emissions from operations within its direct control (scope 1 and 2 emissions).
- Scope 1 and 2 emissions that cannot reasonably be reduced will be offset each year.
- We will continue to prioritise the purchase of high-quality, biodiverse-rich Tasmanian carbon credits.
- We will actively promote stakeholder awareness of energy and emissions reduction opportunities.
- We will support our stakeholders in implementing energy reduction actions.
- To facilitate emissions reductions for our stakeholders, we are committed to actively engaging with tenants and stakeholders to increase awareness of and support the achievement of energy efficiency and sustainability practices.

This policy will be reviewed every two years.
