Hobart Airport parking changes

Hobart Airport is making changes to its car parks to allow for its proposed terminal expansion.

Under the changes, which will come into place as of Friday 9 June, the Short-Term carpark will move to the right-hand side of the pick-up and drop-off area to allow for additional space to be set aside for the terminal.

As a result of this, the Long-Term carpark will move to the site of the current Saver carpark, and the Saver carpark will move directly opposite the Long-Term carpark on the other side of Long Street.

CEO of Hobart Airport, Norris Carter said the changes has been designed to minimise the impact on the travelling public and have been well signposted with refreshed wayfinding signs.

“It’s important that we establish the new parking areas prior to the upgrade of the terminal to reduce inconvenience as much as possible,” Mr Carter said.

“This will also allow us to ensure there is appropriate disability parking, and we’re also planning to introduce undercover parking within the next year.”

Mr Carter said Hobart Airport is well advanced in planning for its runway and terminal upgrades.

“We anticipate announcing the details of the upgrades in the coming months as we work through our planning processes,” Mr Carter said.
