



MORE SEATS FROM HOBART TO PERTH WITH NEW QANTASLINK DIRECT SERVICE

Thursday, 29 May 2025: QantasLink and Hobart Airport have announced direct flights between Hobart and Perth from September, marking the Flying Kangaroo's return to the route for the first time since 2023.

The service will operate three times a week most months of the year and provide an additional 32,000 seats between the Tasmanian and West Australian markets, improving access into both regions for business and leisure travellers.

In a boost for the country's resource sectors, the flights will offer greater connectivity for Tasmanian-based FIFO workers and customers into Western Australia.

Customers can also make the most of new one-stop international options through Qantas' growing western hub in Perth including London, Paris and Rome (seasonal).

The new flights are now available for booking on qantas.com with a special launch fare of \$299 Economy one-way (sale ends 11.59pm AEST on Monday 2 June 2025, unless sold out prior).*

Flight details

- QantasLink's direct Hobart-Perth services will take off from 26 September 2025 and operate year-round (with the exception of May, June and August), flying on Monday, Friday and Sunday.
- Services will be operated by the 150-seat QantasLink A319 aircraft which currently operate intra-WA flights particularly for the resources sector, with 150 economy seats.
- The aircraft are fitted with Q Streaming Entertainment systems, enabling customers to watch a wide range of movies and TV shows on their own devices (note: inflight WiFi is not available on these aircraft).
