

Visitor Identification Card (VIC) Holder Obligations

- Properly display a valid VIC and be supervised by an ASIC holder at all times while in the secure area of a security-controlled airport.
- Leave the secure area immediately if you are at any time not under the supervision and proper control of an ASIC holder.
- The ASIC holder must be able to influence the behaviour of the VIC holder, and be able to control their movement by close proximity.
- Immediately inform your VIC issuer, if your reason for being in the secure area changes.
- Immediately notify your VIC issuer, if your VIC has been lost, stolen or destroyed.
- Return your VIC to your VIC issuer immediately if the card is expired, has been cancelled or damaged or if you no longer have a need to access the secure area of the airport.
- **YOU MAY ONLY ACCESS SECURE AREAS OF AN AIRPORT AS AUTHORISED BY THE VIC ISSUER.**
- Penalties may apply if you fail to meet any of your obligations as a VIC holder.
- You must not be issued with a VIC for more than 28 days within any 12-month period.
- If you need a VIC for more than 28 days, you should consider applying for an ASIC.
